Dreaded triple on the 16th along with the heat would have broken the spirit for many but Ghazzali struck back with a net birdie on the difficult 17th. A perfect te-off and a 2nd shot on the 18th meant that two more good shots would give him the win. Unfortunately, the pressure crept up and got him. Wrong club choice for the 3rd shot, which ended in the hazard, meant that he had to play for a tie. Tying putt stopped 6 inches from the hole giving Ahmed a well-deserved victory.
