Format:

Individual winner (ILN) – Prize: Trophy for the winner.

- Individual stroke play: Every player completes all 18 holes and counts the total number of strokes.
- Player with the lower total net score (gross score minus handicap) wins.
- In case of a tie for the 1st position, the tie breaker rules, outlined in the BAGG handbook, will be applied to determine the winner.

Team winners (Blind Draw - Best Ball) - Prize: Trophy for the winners.

- Every player completes all 18 holes and counts the total number of strokes.
- At the end of the round there will be a 2 player team blind draw. Teams 18-hole net score will be calculated based on best-ball on a hole by hole basis.
- Team with the lowest net wins.
- In case of a tie for the 1st position, the tie breaker rules, outlined in the BAGG handbook, will be applied to determine the winner
