Positives:

Captain's interaction	Both captains (aided by their VC's) worked well together and accommodated the needs	
	of the other team. Pre-tournament logistics were smooth and did not require any	
	intervention from the club management committees. High marks setting up a smooth	
	tournament!	
After game hangout	Satisfying 40+ hungry golfers is a monumental task. Social committee did an excellent	
	job in organizing and managing everybody even after challenges of an hour break	
	between tee-offs and long rounds. It was a very successful get together enjoyed by	
	members of both teams.	
	There is always opportunity for improvement. Possibly consider ordering food in	
	batches to account for groups teeing off later. Shot gun start definitely eliminates some	
	of the scheduling complexities.	
Incident free	Incident free tournament with no formal complaints or issues.	

Areas of Improvement:

Cost	Paying \$73 (includes: cart and range balls) for Spring Valley is expensive. Given that 48 golfers participated options are limited without a shot gun start. Opportunity to explore courses which are willing to explore and consider scheduling the tournament in summer where days are longer.	
Weather	Weather continues to be a challenge in 2019. Playing in wet and muddy conditions added additional time for the round as carts were limited to cart path only and winter rules were in effect (lift, clean & place) were in effect. Consider scheduling the tournament in summer where chances of rain are less.	
Pace of play	There was no round that finished in less than 6 hours and in most cases it took 6 hours and 15 minutes (or more). Some of it can be attributed to rough playing conditions whereas others can be mitigated with formation of groups and on course time management. This is an area that requires attention by captains of both sides in future.
