Summary:

It turned out to be a perfect day for golf and the competition was fierce with a roller coaster ride for the top spot between Faraz, Abdul Waheed and Zile Rehman. As has been the case in this year's tournaments it came down to the last hole.

Waheed has been knocking on the winner's column door for a while. This tournament was no different, he started strong and kept his foot on the gas. It would be fair to say that he brought back Faraz and Zile into the game toward the end of the round. Nerves took over, needing a gross par on the 18th to win the tournament, Waheed took an aggressive approach which did not pan out and he ended up with the 3rd position in the tournament.

Zile had a solid game plan in mind and he stuck with it throughout the game. Managed the course wisely by carefully choosing the clubs and used his handicap to his advantage. He made his move on the 17th by scoring a gross par (net Eagle), secured 5 points and an outright lead of the tournament at 9 points. With Waheed out of the picture all that was needed was a gross double to secure the win. Nerves got the better of him as well, 3 putted from 3 feet and ended up with a quad for the hole and lost 3 valuable points to hand the win to Faraz.

Faraz plays infrequently but always participates in the tournaments. This year he has found a groove and has been in contention multiple times. He almost won the one on one championship (read the story on the BAGG website). Right before he was about to tee-off we were talking about him winning this tournament. His round for the tournament can easily be categorized as a roller coaster ride. Started the round strong and jumped to a sizable lead followed by a stretch of holes where he surrendered the lead. He did not give up, refocused on his game and used his handicap intelligently to post a club house score of 8 points. He needed two of his competitors to falter and this go around lady luck favored him. Well-deserved victory Faraz! You are a proud BAGG champion.

Areas of Improvement:

Free Tools	<p>In order to keep the overhead costs down for BAGG, we use free tools for registering players, online scoring and generating scorecards. Most of the time, they work well with minor or no issues.</p> <p>Unfortunately, this was one tournament where we had trouble with registering people from the get go. Also, had trouble with online scoring.</p> <p>We cannot spend time trying to debug free tools, in many cases support teams will also provide marginal if any support. We must consider buying tools next year which are reliable!</p>
